



THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA 2007 STUDENT FOOTBALL TICKETS

Season Tickets

University of Alabama Football 2007 student season tickets will be available for purchase beginning Monday, April 9th. For your convenience, the student ticket order form will be available exclusively online at <http://www.rolltide.com> (click on Crimson Tide Tickets). There is a limit of one student ticket package per student which is subject to availability.

The student package will be \$42 (\$5 each game plus \$7 handling fee) for all students who are registered and have paid the student activity fee for the fall 2007 semester.

Activity Fees

A student who is enrolled in four hours or less will not be eligible for athletic event reduced rate tickets unless the student purchases additional activity privileges from the Office of Student Receivables. The student and spouse activity fee for the fall 2007 semester will be published at www.cost.ua.edu in late June, 2007.

Road Game Tickets

University of Alabama students who have 65 and above University of Alabama earned hours, as of the end of the fall 2006 semester, will be allowed to place an order for all road games. Students who have less than 65 University of Alabama earned hours will be allowed to place an order for Vanderbilt, Florida State, Ole Miss, and Mississippi State away game tickets. There will be a limit of two and are subject to availability.

Spouse Tickets

For returning students only spouse tickets will be available by contacting the Ticket Office at 348-BAMA or 1-877-TIDETIX. Spouse tickets will be available only to those who have paid the student spouse activity fee prior to picking up the spouse ticket packages. The deadline for ordering the spouse package is May 18th.

Pick Up Instructions

All tickets must be picked up on the dates listed below. A valid 2007 ACTION Card and printed online confirmation page will be required at the time of pick up.

Important Information and FAQ's

What's new for this year?

New Student Mini Packages

Returning students will have from April 9 to May 18th to order Football season tickets exclusively online at www.rolltide.com. These students will have 11,000 full-season (7 game) packages from which to order. The remaining 2,751 season packages will be split into 2 mini plans for *new students*. One plan will feature 3 games and one plan will feature 4 games increasing exposure to 5502 students. The split of the *new student* allotment is intended to cover the increased UA enrollment, giving all *new students* the opportunity to order at least a 3 game package. *New students* may begin purchasing tickets exclusively online at www.rolltide.com June 1 through July 31.

New Road Game Ticket Policy

University of Alabama students who have *65 University of Alabama earned hours* and above, as of the end of the fall 2006 semester, will be allowed to place an order for all road game tickets. Students who have less than 65 University earned hours will be allowed to place an order for Vanderbilt, Florida State, Ole Miss, and Mississippi State away game tickets. There will be a limit of two and those are subject to availability.

Why is the number of games in the new student mini package limited?

In years past, student ticket demand has exceeded supply which affected mostly *new students*. In efforts to allow more students the ability to attend home games, the SGA proposed splitting the season student package.

Didn't you increase the number of tickets allotted for students?

Yes. In 2006, the student section was increased from 12,000 to 15,000. 964 seats are held for the Million Dollar Band and 285 seats held for student-athletes, leaving 13,751 seats for purchase by UA students.

Why not make the ticket ordering process first come-first served?

We have done this in years past, however due to limited supply it leaves many new students unable to purchase tickets. Splitting the home game package will allow more students to attend at least some football games.

Why do some people get 7 games and I only get [3/4]?

All *new students* who purchase student tickets will either receive the 3 game package or 4 game package. *Returning students* receive the full 7 game package due to their seniority.

Do I get to pick which games I want to attend?

We have broken the 7 home games into what we consider to be the fairest packages. Games were ranked based on popularity and broken down with efforts in creating two equally fair packages.

Do new students have to wait until orientation to buy tickets?

No. *New students* purchase tickets beginning June 1.

How will transfer students be treated?

Transfer students will be treated the same as new students.

What if I don't get to buy tickets during the purchase timeframe?

If any student packages remain after the end sale dates, the Ticket Office will sell all remaining tickets beginning August 1.
